KOZAK Denys. Archaeological artifacts of the beginning and first half of the I millennium A.D. in the outskirts of Lviv. P. 5–83.

The author of article gives the description of artifacts of Cherniakhiv, Pshevor and Pragua cultures which were found near Lviv. On this base he studies ethnohistorical process at the beginning of Christian era and during the 1st millenium A.D. in Western regions of Ukraine.

KOMLYK Tetyana. The status of the provincial Danube cities in Roman empire in I–IIIth c. P. 84–93.

The article deals with the problem of the status of the provincial Danube in the I–IIIth c. It is based on the epigraphical sources (CIL) and archaeological excavations. In August's and Hadrianus's time the cities founded as colonia of veterans, that came from the different parts, of empire and kept their traditions. In the II centuries the trib's centers became new cities.

BARAN Volodymyr. The origin of early medieval Slav cultures of Southern-Eastern Europe. P. 94–114.

The author of the article studies ethnical and cultural basis of early medeival Slavonic cultures of Southern-Eastern Europe archeological artifacts of IV–V centuries of Pshevor and Cherniakhiv cultures as an exampl, the author describes the features which continued to develop Slavonik cultures.

MYLIAN Taras. The early Slavonic elements on the settlements IV–V centuries. P. 115–124.

The article relates of Slavonic elements on the Cherniakhiv settlement in upper of Dnister and West Bug rivers regions. There are some settlements: Cherepyn, Neslukhiv, Berezec. We have some Slavonic characteristics – potters, forms of dwelling.

HOLONIUK Tetiana. Changes ethno-cultural environments German tribes of East Europe in conditions of contacts with Roman empire in I–III A.D. P. 125–136.

Within the framework of clause the features of development German are analyzed social and cultural - economic within the limits of the first state formations of East Europe. The aspects of influence of the Roman Empire and her roles in the relations with tribes are considered. German tribes played a role of the leaders in this area and their historical development influenced changes of an ethnic situation.

The article is devoted to participation of the workers of the chair of “Prehistory archeology with the special review of prehistory of Polish lands” of theLviv university Tadeusz Sulimirskij and Markian Smishko in scientific work in 20–30 years of the XX century in Galicia in the conditions of a counteraction of the Polish governmental and university officers. By a vivid example of such activ-ity of Lviv's archeologists was their cooperation with “Bojkivsczyna” society.

POZIKHOVSKYI Oleksandr. The artifacts of the culture of lined-striped ceramics in the middle drainage-basion of Horin river. P. 173–179.

The article covers the history of the research of artifacts of Lined-Striped Culture of Horyn river. The author also describes some very important artifacts.

ONYSHCHUK Yaroslav. The researches of archaeological settlement near Suchovolia, Brody region. P. 180–196.

The information devote of the researche Lviv university expedition. Researched settlemehts of vysots'ka, velbark and raikovets'ka cultures near Suchovolia and Nakvasha Brody region. Fixed housing construction and ceramics material.

The article contains the materials about the archeological research of building of former site of the city of Lystvyn. The special attention is payed to the analysis of underground and on-ground buildings, to the planning of the city, and to the description of artifacts.

DOWGAN Petro. The archaeological research of former site of city in Busk in the suburb of Voliany. P. 254–266.

The article contains the results of archaeological research in 2000 in the site of Voliany, which is situated in western-northern suburb of Busk. The materials let the conclusion that there was a cemetery in this site in XVIIth century. On the base of these materials the author describes the existence of the city in XIIth-XVIIth centuries, and the fire during one of these periods.

BEREST Roman. The archaeological research of Univ old monastery in 2000. P. 267–290.

The information devoted to research of Univ old monastery. This is the original memorial of the black clergy in Ukraine. As a result of this work was fixed old monastery building 16th century and ground burial.

RUDYJ Vasyl'. Monastery of a late middle ages near the village Josypovychi, Stryj region. P. 291–304.

On Galiciana cult facilities arise from time of Christianity of peasantry. The monastery Exaltation of a Cross near village Josypovychi, monument of a late middle ages, was consolidated by the earthen arbor and ditch. On a conventual court yard there were church, mansions of the abbot and friars.

PETRYK Vasyl', PETRYK Andriy, TYMOSHENKO Leonid. The archaeological research the rest of the St. Maria church in Drohobych. P. 305–315.

The information presents the result of the archaeological research the rest of the St. Maria church in 2001. As a result of this work are traces of well-planned places in 18th - 19th centuries, ground burial 17th - 18th centuries and archaeological materials 12th - 19th centuries.

OSAULCHUK Oleg, SHYSHAK Volodymyr. The archaeological and architectural researches of the defensive synagogue in Zhovkva. P. 316–343.

The information devoted to archaeological and architectural researches of the defensive synagogue 17th centuries in Zhovkva, give description of the archaeological materials 17th - 19th centuries, structure of the site sediments.

MARTYNIUK Sviatoslav. Glassworks of late XVI – early XVII centuries in the vicinity of the forests of Univ Holy Assumption Laura. P. 344–361.

The article presents systematized materials of archaeological investigations of the furnace for ancient colored glass manufacture, which was used on the turn of the 16th–17th centuries in the vicinity of Univ Holy Assumption Laura. The glass manufacture at the glassworks was made in Venetian tradition. A reliable reconstruction of production and artistic parameters of colored glass, became possible owing to well-preserved relics of the three furnaces and a large number of findings, refractory materials, tools.

LOSZYK Maria. Physico-chemical investigations of refractory materials and colored glass of late XVI – early XVII centuries in Univ Holy Assumption Laura. P. 362–378.

The article describes the results of investigations of materials, and ancient colored glass, produced at glassworks in late 16th - early 17th centuries in the vicinity of the old Univ monastery. Investigation of the said materials were carried out with application of the most advanced modern scientific methods. The complex of physico-chemical and X-ray structural investigations permits to determine characteristic peculiarities of the process of glazing of glass in question as well as role and composition of refractory materials in glass manufacture.
