

**PEDAGOGICAL ACTIVITY
OF YAKIV HOLOVATS'KYI IN L'VIV UNIVERSITY
(in context of development of Ukrainian people studies and Slavic studies)**

The article is written on the basis of the materials taken from Ya.Holovats'kyi archive at the manuscript department of Stefanyk National Library in L'viv and publications about academic and pedagogical activity of the scholar. It attempts to study the subject-matters of lectures delivered by the professor and establish their connection to the objectives of the Ukrainian Studies of the period and to the level of development of the Slavic Studies in Europe.

It has been discovered that pedagogical activity of Ya.Holovats'kyi was broad and multifaceted, had a theoretical as well as applied direction, featured both strong positive and noticeable weak traits. In particular, historical and comparative approach which were further developed by heads of department prove that Ya.Holovats'kyi established a base for the Ukrainian Studies in the University and was one of the founders of Slavic Studies there.

Simultaneously the focus on bygone processes of the Ukrainian literature development, delivering lectures using *yazychiye* (a distorted Russian language used in Halychyna), resenting the underlying folk tradition in creation of standard Ukrainian language in Halychyna and some other features of Ya.Holovats'kyi's activity had a negative impact on the overall image of the department and prevented it from becoming the centre of Ukrainian Studies in Halychyna.
